## Covid-19 Discretionary Local Restrictions Support and Additional Restrictions Grants Policy (Addendum) – 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021 – 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021

## **Introduction**

Government have announced a new business support package for the January 2021 lockdown. In accordance with the new support package Barnet have created an Additional Restrictions Grant (Addendum) policy.

This addendum supersedes the awards in the main policy. Under this addendum Additional Restrictions Grants will be awarded for the period 5<sup>th</sup> January to 15<sup>th</sup> February (6 weeks) and will include a one-off grant.

This Additional Restrictions Grant is fully funded by Central Government and the funds will be administered by the council in accordance with Barnet's original <u>Covid-19</u> <u>Discretionary Local Restrictions Support and Additional Restrictions Grants Policy</u> and this addendum whilst taking into account guidance issued by the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) and the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG).

For eligibility criteria, exclusions and policy guidelines please refer to Barnet's <u>Covid-19</u> <u>Discretionary Local Restrictions Support and Additional Restrictions Grants Policy</u>. The application process remains unchanged.

## **Funding Levels**

The table below provides the maximum levels of funding available for each business applying:
