Working Group Feedback



In May and June 2016 we ran some trial working groups to test the new way of working. One of the working groups had the opportunity to work with a designer and develop a name and logo for Barnet's new community based social care hubs.

The name and logos are now being used throughout the borough and the photo below shows one of the banners in our offices.


At Care Space, you can find out about care and support services available to help you stay independent, healthy and well. It offers:

Consultation Feedback



In July 2016, we held three consultation events on our proposals to change the way we deliver and organise Adult Social Care in Barnet.

The feedback from these events formed part of the report that was taken to the Adults and Safeguarding Committee on Monday 19 September.

The Committee agreed to the two key recommendations in the report which were:

- to implement the new way of working within the current structure of Adult Social Care
- to continue to develop two new ways of organising Adult Social Care in Barnet, which will be:
 - changing the way Barnet Council currently organises Adult Social Care
 - delivering a joint service with the NHS.

The Committee also highlighted the importance when developing a joint service with the NHS that we maintain accountable to members of the council.

A further report will be taken to the Adults and Safeguarding Committee in March 2017, which will have more detail on the two options above.
