Who are we?

- The Deborah Hutton Campaign is a peer-to-peer youth smoking prevention charity
- Our short film project, Cut Films, educates young people about smoking and tobacco in a creative way
- We are running a Barnet Cut Films Competition aimed at young people under 25.

What can we offer you?

- We are offering film workshops with a professional filmmaking youth worker to educate students on tobacco & teach them filmmaking techniques (storyboarding, camera & editing)
- We are offering assemblies to schools about anti-smoking and the competition
- We are offering teacher training as part of Barnet's Wellbeing Programme.
 The sessions are titled "Educating Young People on the Effects of Smoking:

Operation Smokestorm

- Interactive smoking prevention resource
- Brand new style of learning resource which targets this problem by creating a lifesaving shift in teens' attitudes towards smoking and the tobacco industry
- An interactive resource that promotes truly effective learning by delivering a mix of personal reasoning, problem solving and group collaboration activities
- What's required of teachers? Very little! During each session all facts are delivered via an online fusion of short films and interactive group games.
 Teachers simply need to follow the guidance notes provided and click the mouse when prompted

Sexual Health- Primary Schools (SRE) Support

A comprehensive SRE resource package

- •Schemes of work (understanding relationships, managing feelings, importance of maintaining good health)
- •Recommendation of resources (in line with current guidelines)

Consultancy support to teaching staff

- •Bespoke support to meet individual need of schools (using SRE resource package)
- Flexible- dictated by schools

Training to build capacity within schools

- •Training for teaching, non-teaching staff and volunteers to ensure that they have the knowledge & skills to deliver SRE effectively.
- •The training will include support to help parents or carers develop their SRE skills





Sexual Health- Secondary Schools Clinic in a Box & SRE

- Clinic in a box- Improved knowledge and access to clinical and other services for advice information & support
 - Reducing risk of unplanned pregnancies especially among at-risk young people
 - Promoting knowledge about contraception and how to use it safely and effectively
 - Raising awareness about sexually transmitted infections and their diagnosis and treatment
 - Increase access to condom distribution scheme for young people
 - Will be provided to some schools by specialist nurses (based on location, inclination and SRE programme)





Drugs and Alcohol Prevention

Aim: A service for alcohol and substance misuse prevention in primary and secondary schools including

- Training for staff (including PSHE delivery staff)
- Development of resources and lesson plans
- Supported by a coordinator

Outcomes

- Empower children to make better decisions when confronted with alcohol and drugs
- Improve children and young peoples knowledge of drug and alcohol misuse
- Provider confirmed Jan 2014
